ADD-ON Travel Program to Faenza and Ravenna €340 double room add €160 single supplement A few days of traveling after the workshop to Faenza and the International Ceramics Museum and home of the Ceramica Biennale, Carlo Zauli Museum plus artists studios. Then Ravenna, a World Heritage Site of Mosaics from Byzantine and Roman periods of 4-6th Century. Includes museum entries, trains and three nights of hotels.
